**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act permitting the extension of hours that miners may spend underground."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 **\* Section 1.** AS 23.10.410 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (d) An employer may request an exemption from the requirements of this  
5 section to permit the employer to employ employees underground for longer than eight  
6 hours in 24 hours. If the commissioner determines that an extension is in the best  
7 interest of the employer and the employees, the commissioner may grant the  
8 exemption. The department shall implement this subsection by regulation.
