A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to commercial fishing penalties."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 16.05.710 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (e) The Department of Public Safety shall compile and maintain a list of
5 persons convicted of a misdemeanor or felony violation of a commercial fishing law
6 of this state within the preceding 10 years. The list must contain a record of all
7 misdemeanor and felony convictions of commercial fishing laws of this state within
8 the preceding 10 years for each person on the list. The list is a public record and is
9 available to the public.

10 * **Sec. 2.** AS 16.05.722(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) A person who without any culpable mental state violates AS 16.05.440 -
12 16.05.690, or a regulation of the Board of Fisheries or the department governing

1 commercial fishing, is guilty of a violation and upon conviction is punishable by a fine
2 of not more than

3 (1) \$6,000 [\$3,000] for a first conviction; and

4 (2) \$12,000 [\$6,000] for a second or subsequent conviction.
