**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Relating to the twenty-seventh annual Boys' State.**

2 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 **WHEREAS** the twenty-seventh annual Boys' State will be held June 5 - 12, 1993, at  
4 the Elks Camp in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough under the sponsorship of the American  
5 Legion and cooperating organizations; and

6 **WHEREAS** this fine annual program is dedicated to increasing the delegates'  
7 awareness of their future roles in state and local government as well as promoting interest and  
8 knowledge about the operation of our system of government; and

9 **WHEREAS** it is only through an admirable combination of volunteer effort and the  
10 enterprising talents of generous individuals who do not receive government or taxpayer  
11 monetary support that this week-long youth citizenship exercise known as Boys' State takes  
12 place; and

13 **WHEREAS** the legislature encourages state and local legislators and other public  
14 officials and agencies to volunteer their services and to provide copies of state publications  
15 and materials related to the program;

16 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Alaska State Legislature applauds the sponsors of and

1 participants in the twenty-seventh annual Boys' State program; commends those government  
2 officials and agencies and private individuals and organizations who support and participate  
3 in this exercise in youth citizenship; and promises to continue to provide legislative materials,  
4 advice, and encouragement to the Boys' State program as it does to similar worthy civic  
5 efforts.
