10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the general

13 protection, ^{to lease equipment} ~~to lease a helicopter~~ for enforcement purposes in southcentral
14 Alaska, including Kodiak and the Alaska Peninsula.
