This amount is figured at 450 election boards with 4 people per board, working 17 hours each, per election for \$153,000. It also includes 4 members of the Absentee Canvass Boards in the 4 areas of the State for a total of 16 members working approximately 35 hours each, per election for \$2,800. Then the State Canvass Board of 4 members at 8 days with approximately 32 hours each, per election, for \$1,280. The remainder of \$6,400 is for payment of miscellaneous counting teams for the Absentee Canvass Board, Punch Card Boards and Incorporation Election Boards. These figures are for one election, on election years we hold both the Primary and General election so they would have to be doubled. The figures for the off election years
