

III. ANALYSIS (See Fiscal Note Preparation Instructions, Section III)

H.B. 238 requires the appointment of a guardian ad litem in all legal proceedings involving the welfare of a child. Appointments would therefore be made in divorce, dependency, delinquency or any other cases in which a child's interests are affected by court action. It is impossible to estimate the exact cost of this bill. The best estimate at this time is \$300,000. per year. This cost could conceivably go as high as \$1,000,000. per year.



The Health, Education and Social Services Committee has had SPONSOR SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 256 (temporary permits to practice dentistry) under consideration and a majority of the members of the Committee recommends it do pass with the following amendment:

Page 1, line 9: Delete "shall" and insert "may".

SPONSOR SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 256 was referred to the Judiciary Committee.

The Finance Committee has had SPONSOR SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 297 (oil and gas reserves ad valorem tax; effective date) under consideration and a majority of the members of the Committee recommends it be replaced with COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SPONSOR SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 297 (Finance)(same title) and that it do pass. The report was signed by Mr. Malone, Chairman, and concurred in by Cowper, Gruening, Naughton, Malone, Duncan and Buchholdt. Not concurring were Haugen and Itta who recommend do not pass.

SPONSOR SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 297 was referred to the Rules Committee for placement on the calendar.

HB 307 The State Affairs Committee has had HOUSE BILL NO. 300 (relating to state elections) under consideration and a majority of the members of the Committee recommends it be replaced with COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 300 (same title) and that it do pass. The report was signed by Mr. Parker, Chairman, and concurred in by Wallis, Miller, McKinnon and Parker. Not concurring were H. Beirne who has no recommendation and M. Beirne and Fischer who recommend do not pass.

HOUSE BILL NO. 300 was referred to the Finance Committee.

HB 339 The Commerce Committee has had HOUSE BILL NO. 339 (requiring packages of a commodity offered for retail sale to be marked with the price) under consideration and the members of the Committee recommend it be replaced with COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 339

The report was signed by Mrs. Sullivan, Chairman. Recommending do pass were Davis, Ose, Swanson and Osterback. Recommending do not pass were Ostrosky, Parr, Sullivan and H. Beirne. Having no recommendation was Hackney.
