6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing the Alaska Fire Fighter Training
7 Center Commission; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The Alaska Fire Fighter Training Center Commission is
11 established in the Office of the Governor.

12 * Sec. 2. The commission consists of the commissioner of education or
13 his designee, the commissioner of community and regional affairs or his
14 designee, and five additional members appointed by the governor. The
15 governor shall appoint one engineer, one architect, and three persons with
16 Alaska fire fighting experience to the commission. The commission shall
17 select a chairman from its membership. Terms of all members end and the
18 commission is dissolved February 1, 1976.

19 * Sec. 3. The commission shall recommend a state plan to facilitate
20 regional training of fire fighters. In carrying out these responsibilities
21 the commission may:

- 22 (1) recommend sites for location of four training centers;
23 (2) determine if the centers can be constructed in conjunction
24 with other training facilities;
25 (3) recommend a common physical design for the centers;
26 (4) formulate cost estimates for implementing its recommendations.

27 * Sec. 4. No later than January 1, 1976 the commission shall submit to
28 the governor a comprehensive report incorporating its specific recommendations
29 regarding the establishment of regional fire fighter training centers in the

1 state. The commission is not limited to recommendations suggested by sec. 3
2 of this Act.

3 * Sec. 5. Members of the commission serve without compensation but are
4 entitled to per diem and travel expenses authorized by law for other boards
5 and commissions.

6 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
7 070(c).
