III. ANALYSIS (See Fiscal Note Preparation Instructions, Section III.)

Administrative costs include travel from Juneau to Anchorage and Fairbanks for two staff members with one continuing on to Bethel and the second to Nome to conduct Administrative Procedure Act hearings under sec. 44.47.250 of the bill. An additional \$1,000 in travel is required for review of grant applications and post-project review. \$50 per location is the estimate of publication of hearing notices and \$150 will cover central duplicating and postage expenses for printing and distribution of regulations. Administrative and clerical support will be provided by the staff of the Local Government Assistance Division.
