SUBJECT: HB 342

Relating to special vehicle registration plates for handicapped persons, this bill is virtually a verbatim duplicate of the provisions which we developed with Rep. Beirne (thru assistant Randy Phillips) for inclusion in Chapter 10 of our proposed new Title 28. Because the new AS 28 is to be introduced late this session for referral to interim consideration, in effect relegating any passage of bills to a year hence, Rep. Beirne has developed this "copy" for enactment this year relevant to current AS 28.10. Joe Hill's review and revision is present in both versions.

The intent of HB 342 is to provide persons who are 70% handicapped means of identification upon their vehicle that will allow them to park or stand in specific designated areas without arrest. An alternate method of providing the service other than an expensive plate/data processing system would be to have the Div. of Motor Vehicles or a law enforcement agency issue bumper decals annually, providing the appropriate information an design.

HB 342 does not provide for the plate to stay with the individual but with the vehicle, i.e., if the vehicle is sold the plate would not be transferred with the person, but would stay with the vehicle. The Bill does not refer to automobiles only, but refers only to the \$30 fee. If fees were changed it would no longer refer to automobiles but to any vehicle.
