10 \* Section 1. The sum of \$115,600 is appropriated from the general fund  
11 to the Department of Labor, Wage and Hour Division, to provide funds for  
12 the Alaska Plan Equivalency Panel, and for the hiring of five investigators  
13 and four clerical workers to enforce Alaska Law requiring the hiring of  
14 qualified Alaska residents on oil and gas leases, easements or right-of-way  
15 permits for oil or gas pipeline purposes.

16 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-  
17 10.070(c).
