9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 39.35.360(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) An employee who completes three years of service with the
12 state after January 1, 1961, for which he makes contributions required
13 by this chapter is entitled to service credit for employment rendered
14 to the State and former Territory of Alaska before January 1, 1961,
15 regardless of the office, department, division, or agency of the state
16 or territory in which he was employed, including service as a commis-
17 sioned officer of the United States Public Health Service, the United
18 States District Court and the United States Commissioner's Court
19 serving the Territory and State of Alaska succeeded to by the Alaska
20 court system, and persons employed as United States marshals, United
21 States deputy marshals, and Civil Aeronautics Administration security
22 guards, and persons employed by the former Alaska Road Commission,
23 Bureau of Public Roads, Region 10, Department of Public Works, United
24 States Employment Service and War Manpower Commission. The retirement
25 benefits payable to an employee under this section which are attri-
26 butable to employment rendered to the State and former Territory of
27 Alaska before January 1, 1961, shall be reduced by the amount of the
28 retirement pension benefits paid to him by the United States government
29 for the same period of prior service.
