Travel funds for the Office of Drug Abuse have been reduced below request for two consecutive years. The only way required staff travel and advisory board travel has been realized is by not appointing the full 12 members of the board. Board members receive \$50.00 per day for any day or portion that they travel, plus travel costs. These costs are increasing.

Licensing and review of federal grants will be done by existing staff members at no additional cost.

3 board members at \$50 per day X 4 days each meeting X 4 meetings per year + cost of ticket X 3 people X 4 meetings was the formula used to derive savings.
