6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obliga-
7 tion bonds in the amount of \$4,590,000 for the purpose
8 of paying the cost of construction, reconstruction,
9 and acquisition of public safety facilities and
10 equipment; and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of construction, re-
13 construction, and acquisition of public safety facilities and equipment,
14 general obligation bonds of the state in the principal amount of not more
15 than \$4,590,000 shall be issued and sold. The full faith, credit and
16 resources of the state are pledged to the payment of the principal of and
17 interest and redemption premium, if any, on these bonds. These bonds shall
18 be issued under the provisions of AS 37.15 as those provisions read at the
19 time of issuance.

20 * Sec. 2. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
21 voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the 1976
22 Public Safety Construction Fund shall be established, to which shall be
23 credited the proceeds of the sale of the bonds described in sec. 1 of this
24 Act except for the accrued interest and premiums. There is appropriated
25 from the 1976 Public Safety Construction Fund to the Department of Public
26 Safety the amount of \$4,590,000. To the extent feasible, the proceeds of
27 these bonds shall be allocated by the governor in accordance with the
28 following projects and estimates:

11 * Sec. 3. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
12 voters of the state, the amount of \$16,065 or as much of that amount as if
13 found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
14 state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay
15 expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this
16 Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized by this section
17 shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the sale of
18 the bonds authorized by this Act.

19 * Sec. 4. The amount withdrawn from the Public Facility Planning Fund
20 for the purpose of advance planning for the improvements financed under
21 this Act shall be reimbursed to the fund from the proceeds of the sale of
22 bonds authorized by this Act.

23 * Sec. 5. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are to
24 be issued shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state at the
25 next state general election and shall read substantially as follows:

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements
12 to health care facilities, general obligation bonds of the state in the
13 principal amount of not more than \$4,150,000 shall be issued and sold. The
14 full faith, credit and resources of the state are pledged to the payment of
15 the principal of and interest and redemption premium, if any, on these bonds.
16 These bonds shall be issued under the provisions of AS 37.15 as those pro-
17 visions read at the time of issuance.

18 * Sec. 2. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
19 voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the "1976
20 Health Care Facilities Construction Fund" shall be established, to which
21 shall be credited the proceeds of the sale of the bonds described in sec. 1
22 of this Act except for the accrued interest and premiums. There is appropri-
23 ated from the "1976 Health Care Facilities Construction Fund" to the Depart-
24 ment of Health and Social Services the amount of \$4,150,000. To the extent
25 feasible, the proceeds of these bonds shall be allocated by the governor in
26 accordance with the following projects and estimates:

9 expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this
10 Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized by this section
11 shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the sale of the
12 bonds authorized by this Act.
