For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to Alaska National Guard and Alaska
Naval Militia educational assistance."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 26.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 26.05.296. EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE. (a) To the extent funds are available, the adjutant general shall authorize the payment of not more than 50 per cent of the cost of tuition and required fees for each active member of the Alaska National Guard or the Alaska Naval Militia who attends an educational, vocational, or technical training school in Alaska. Payments authorized under this section continue so long as the member participates satisfactorily in unit training activities and pursues the course of study in a manner acceptable to the school.

(b) Persons who have established eligibility for educational assistance benefits under the Veterans' Administration education program (38 U.S.C. secs. 1651 - 1687) or any other educational benefits by having served in active or reserve forces of the United States other than those mentioned in (a) of this section are not eligible for educational assistance under this section.

* Sec. 2. AS 26.05.295 is repealed.

METHOD OF COMPUTATION:

Tuition at U of A costs \$160/Student/Semester for full time students.
 $\$160 \times 50\% = \80 Cost/Student/Semester $\times 200$ participants = 16,000/Semester
 $\times 3$ Semesters (including summer students) = \$48,000.

Increase of 10% per year for normal cost increases.
