Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with AS 24.30.060(b) and the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, I am transmitting a bill for a supplemental appropriation to fund necessary expenditures for initial review of the gas pipeline proposals. This review of the proposals submitted by the competing gas companies will be conducted primarily to insure that consideration is given to Alaska's unique environment. The staff of the Office of the Pipeline Coordinator will provide technical support to other state agencies involved in determining the routing of the gas line and conditions of the right-of-way lease. The involvement of the State of Alaska in the initial planning stages will eliminate the possibility of having to accept or attempt to change criteria already developed by industry.

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

NINTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act making a supplemental appropriation to the Office of the Governor, Pipeline Coordinator; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$74,600 is appropriated from the general fund to the Office of the Governor, Pipeline Coordinator, for Fiscal Year 1976, for the purpose of gas pipeline review.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-10.070(c).
