SUBJECT: CCHB 708 and HB 709

FINDINGS:

1) Purpose and Administration

- a. That the concept of (Sec. 14.40.850) the "internship program" is an expanded version of a "University Action Year" program now on-going at the Anchorage Community College involving some 40 students.

Note: All accredited institutions are eligible; including Sheldon Jackson Junior College and through SJJC Barrow's Inuipiat Community College.

- b. That the "University Action Year" regulations are now in existence and that new regulations (Sec. 14.40.855) will be written pursuant to and in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act.

2) Fund Distribution/Student Eligibility/Compensation

- a. In figures the funding picture is as follows:

- a-1) Federal funds for '77 - '78 will be in the amount of \$74,000 and is to be the last. The assumption is that the Alaska State will take over after FY '78.
- b) Alaska State students enrolled in accredited post-secondary educational institutions are eligible to participate. Student employment agreement terms will be necessary (Sec. 14.40.870).

Student participant may not necessarily have to be a high school graduate. (P.3;L.14)

Notes:

- 1) For both '76 - '77 and '77 - '78 program years - an estimated 120 students may participate.
- 2) Reported indications of interest by Public Health Nurses Association and Alaska Federation of Natives on behalf of non-profit native organization.
