6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sick leave bank; and providing

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.14.105 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.14.105. SICK LEAVE BANK. A local school district board,
11 or the board of a regional educational attendance area [DIRECTORS OF THE
12 STATE-OPERATED SCHOOL SYSTEM], may establish a sick leave bank to enable
13 a teacher, because of unusual circumstances, to draw not more than twice
14 the number of days of sick leave the teacher has accumulated before the
15 first day of school in any school year, or 24 days, whichever is greater.
16 The board may establish and administer the sick leave bank independently
17 or jointly with teachers.

18 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
19 070(e).
