10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The amount of \$242,800 is appropriated to the Department of
12 Administration for the purpose of paying salary increases for supervisors and
13 confidential employees for fiscal year 1976. This appropriation is from the
14 following sources:

15 State General Fund	\$217,100
16 Highway Working Capital Fund	5,300
17 International Airport Revenue Fund	3,400
18 Federal Funds	17,000

19 * Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of AS 37.07.080(e) pertaining to
20 appropriation transfers, the division of budget and management is authorized
21 to transfer the appropriated amounts shown in sec. 1 of this Act between
22 program categories or agencies as required for salary or per diem increase
23 purposes.

24 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
