13 administration, [AND] the commissioner of revenue and the chairmen of  
14 the house and senate finance committees. If a member of the committee  
15 is absent or otherwise unable to act, his designee, from within the same  
16 department or legislative committee [IN THE DEPARTMENT] shall act as a  
17 member of the committee in his place.
