7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 28.10.200(b)(4) is amended to read:

9 (4) for a motor vehicle, whether or not [INCLUDING A MOTOR  
10 VEHICLE] pulling a trailer or semi-trailer, [DESIGNED,] used [,] or  
11 maintained [PRIMARILY] for the commercial transportation of passengers  
12 for hire, excepting taxicabs, and excepting buses taxed under (b)(5) of  
13 this section, or for the commercial transportation or hauling of pro-  
14 perty, including, but not limited to, a [COMMERCIAL] vehicle such as a  
15 trailer, semi-trailer, truck, wrecker, tow car, hearse, ambulance, and  
16 truck-tractor, a tax based upon the actual unladen weight as established  
17 by the manufacturer's advertised weight, or upon the actual weight which  
18 the owner has the responsibility of furnishing, subject to the approval  
19 of the commissioner or his agent, as follows:

20 5,000 [4,000] pounds or less.....\$ 45;

21 5,001 [4,001] pounds and not over 12,000 pounds..... 80;

22 12,001 pounds and not over 18,000 pounds..... 150;

5 Sec. 28.10.360. NEW OWNER TO SECURE TRANSFERS. The transferee  
6 shall present the certificate of registration and certificate of title,  
7 properly endorsed, accompanied by a fee of \$5, to the department within  
8 30 [10] days following transfer of ownership, and shall apply for a  
9 new certificate of title and obtain a new registration for the vehicle,  
10 except as permitted in sec. 390 of this chapter. There is a \$25 penalty  
11 for the violation of the 30- [10-] day provision of this section.
