16 er must have received a discharge other than dishonorable. Credit for
17 service in the armed forces shall be granted only if the teacher makes
18 contributions for the service in the same manner as required for outside
19 service under sec. 60 of this chapter. The military service credited
20 under this section shall be included in the 10 year limitation of outside
21 service as specified in sec. 60 of this chapter, except, if entry into
22 the armed forces is immediately preceded by Alaska membership service and,
23 following discharge, is continued by Alaska membership service within one
24 year thereafter, service may not be counted for purposes of determining
25 the applicability of the 10 year limitation on outside service.
