You have before the Finance Committee the above measure, which is basically a technical "housekeeping" bill to clarify and implement, as well as correct, provisions of ch. 78, SLA 1974, which established the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education.

Section 3 of that bill was enacted by sec. 1, ch. 135, SLA 1975, and no longer is necessary; thus at the time the bill is considered in committee or reported to the floor for action, the following amendment should be adopted:

On page 1, strike out lines 26 - 29, inclusive, and on page 2, strike out lines 1 and ~~2~~, and renumber sections 4 - 6 of the bill, accordingly.
