7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 35.27 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 CHAPTER 27. ART WORKS AND INSTRUCTION CENTERS
10 IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES.

11 Sec. 35.27.05. INSTRUCTION CENTER REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC BUILD-
12 INGS. (a) Plans for public buildings designed to accommodate more than
13 40 employees or which are the main public building in a small community,
14 as determined by the department, constructed after June 30, 1976, and
15 plans for remodeling or renovation of those buildings after June 30
16 1976, when the total cost of remodeling or renovation is \$250,000 or
17 more, shall contain provisions for the inclusion of not less than one
18 instructor center.

19 (b) An instruction center is not required for a building specified
20 in (a) of this section if the Department of Education, after notifica-
21 tion of the plan, files a written determination with the Department of
22 Public Works explaining the reason the facility is not required.

23 (c) In this section "instruction center" means a room or enclosed
24 area or space created for the purpose of employee educational training
25 and employee or community meetings.

26 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
