8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 24.20.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 24.20.020. MEMBERSHIP. The legislative council is a manage-
11 ment council composed of 14 members: the presiding officer, the majority
12 leader, the minority leader, the finance committee chairman, the rules
13 committee chairman, and two other members from each house. The two
14 additional members from each house are appointed by the presiding officer
15 of each house. The appointment of members shall be announce^d within 15
16 days of the convening of the first regular session of each legislature.

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 10, 1977.
