The attached draft bill provides for special appropriation in the amount of \$87,000 from the general fund.

There does not appear to be a need to spell out the entire detail of the program in the legislation since the Alaska Rural Teacher Training Corps. is a well established program in the State. Their method of operation dovetails closely with the research outline you sent us.

In Section 3 of the bill, the appropriation is made contingent upon the receipt of Federal funds. The reason for this is that virtually the entire budget for the ARTTC comes from Federal sources as can be seen in Governor Hammonds's FY77 Budget Request. Without receipt of Federal funds, it would not be feasible to conduct this program in just one area with state funds.
