8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 37.07.070 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 37.07.070. LEGISLATIVE REVIEW. The legislature shall consider  
11 the governor's proposed comprehensive program and financial plan, evalu-  
12 ate alternatives to the plan, make program selections among the various  
13 alternatives and determine, subject to available revenues, the level of  
14 funding required to support authorized state services. During each  
15 regular session of the legislature, legislative review of the plan shall  
16 be accomplished according to the following schedule:

17 (1) By the 45th legislative day, the legislature shall have  
18 established by resolution the total amount of state general funds that  
19 shall be available for appropriation for the budget year and the tenta-  
20 tive allocation of the funds among program categories in both the  
21 operating and capital budgets.

22 (2) By the 90th legislative day, the house in which the  
23 general appropriations Act was introduced by the governor shall have  
24 calendared for second reading a version of the general appropriations  
25 Act. The bill shall be supported with documentation to explain the  
26 proposed appropriations and related statements of intent. In addition,  
27 a list of other appropriations or measures with fiscal implications  
28 pending before the legislature shall be included with the documentation  
29 for the calendared bill.

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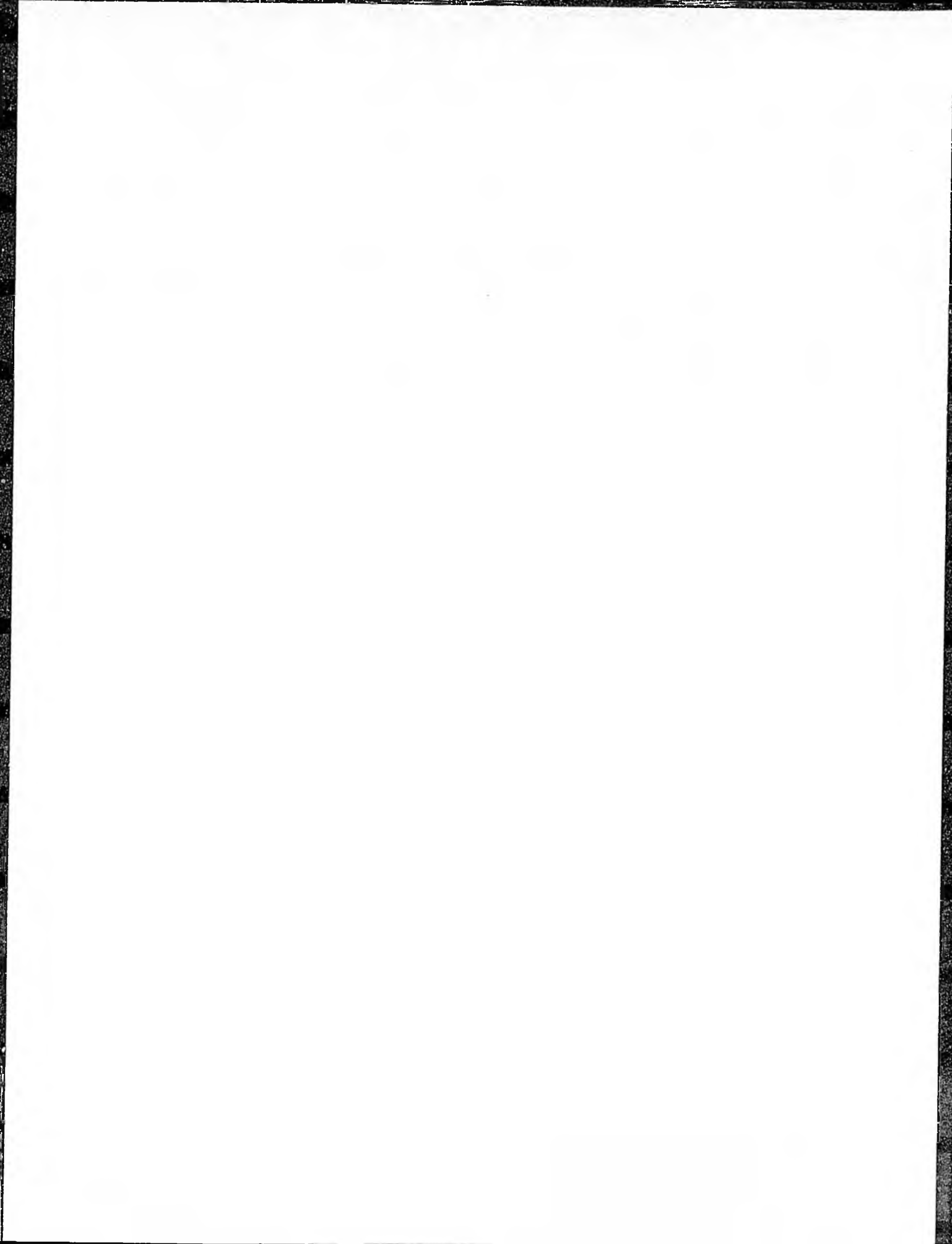
