
COMMITTEE REPORT ON COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 152


It is the intent of the Senate Health, Education, and Social Services Committee in passing out Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 152 to provide funds to the University of Alaska through the Legislative Affairs Agency. This money can be used for the University Task Force in telecommunications policy and planning.

The Committee recognizes the expertise of Professors Glenn Stanley and Robert Merritt and feels their efforts towards statewide telecommunications planning should be continued.

This funding extends through the remainder of this fiscal year and through FY 76.

The Senate Health, Education and Social Services Committee feels that telecommunications is one of Alaska's major priorities and the need for planning at this stage is critical.
