III. ANALYSIS (See Fiscal Note Preparation Instructions, Section III)

SB 189 allows a person to continue receiving the longevity bonus while remaining out-of-state for a period up to 180 consecutive days. At the present time monthly checks are not mailed out-of-state. Based on the calendar year ended December 1975, an average of 240 persons per month (2,886 annually) were out-of-state who would be eligible to receive the bonus under SB 189 who would not presently be entitled. It is estimated they would receive the check for an average of 1 month.

$$240 \times \$100 = \$24,000 \times 12 = \$288,000.$$

Assumes a 5% increase in the number of individuals affected each year.

Appendix I - SB 189

1. Under SB 189, I am assuming a person could remain out of State for a period up to 180 consecutive days without losing eligibility for a monthly bonus check.
2. At the present time monthly checks are not mailed out of State. If this Bill is passed a substantial amount of money would be sent out of the State.
3. It is assumed that an average of 45 additional persons a month would be getting a check under this Bill who wouldn't otherwise be entitled and would receive such checks for an average of 4 months.

$$45 \times 12 \times \$100 \times 4 = \$216,000 \text{ in FY 76}$$

4. Assume effective date of 7/1/75
5. Assume a 5% increase in number of individuals affected each year.
