6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to authorizing the Department of
7 Military Affairs to make expenditures to meet extra-
8 ordinary expenditures and shortfalls in revenue of
9 boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school
10 districts incurred as a result of the natural disaster
11 declared November 14, 1974; and providing for an
12 effective date."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

14 * Section 1. The Department of Military Affairs is authorized to make
15 expenditures of \$380,000 or such part as is necessary to carry out the
16 provisions of this Act, to meet extraordinary expenditures and shortfalls in
17 revenue of boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts
18 in that area of the state declared a natural disaster area by President
19 Ford's proclamation of November 14, 1974, where the extraordinary expenses
20 and shortfalls in revenue were caused by the natural disaster.

21 * Sec. 2. No funds may be disbursed under this Act until the borough,
22 city, municipal utility system or school district qualifying for the funds
23 has applied to the department in the manner to be prescribed by the depart-
24 ment. Boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts
25 receiving funds under this Act shall account to the department for the expen-
26 ditures of the funds.

27 * Sec. 3. No funds shall be approved for disbursement under this Act after
28 June 30, 1976.

29 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.
