Senate Bill No. 719 binds home rule and general law municipalities to the special assessment payment procedures and limitations as set forth in AS 29.63.060.

The bill has no state fiscal implications.

The bills intent is apparently to protect a taxpayer from being billed a lump sum assessment or installment of an assessment in one year which exceeds 25% of the assessed value of the property affected.
