IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act making a special appropriation to the Department of Education, division of libraries and museums, to provide grant funds for the construction of comfort station facilities at the Colony Village Museum and Tourist Center and the agricultural museum at the Tanana Valley Fairgrounds; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$46,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education, division of libraries and museums, to be available for a capital improvement grant for construction of a comfort station for women and children at the Colony Village Museum and Tourist Center located at mile 40, Glenn Highway and owned and operated by the Alaska State Fair Historical, Educational and Arts Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit corporation.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$45,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education, division of libraries and museums, to be available for a capital improvement grant for the construction or improvement of comfort station facilities serving the agricultural museum operated by the Tanana Valley Fair Association and located on the Tanana Valley Fairgrounds.

* Sec. 3. The unexpended and unobligated portion of this appropriation lapses into the general fund June 30, 1978.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1977.
