THE FLESH OF HERRING TAKEN DURING THE FISHING SEASON IS OF LITTLE VALUE FOR FURTHER PROCESSING AND FOR REDUCTION TO MEAL.

LIMITING PROCESSING OF BOE HERRING TO FULL UTILIZATION WILL ELIMINATE MANY JOBS AND WASTE MUCH OF THE FISHING EFFORT.

UNTIL FACILITIES IN ALL AREAS WHERE BOE HERRING IS PROCESSED ARE DEVELOPED FOR FULL UTILIZATION, SB49 PASSAGE SHOULD BE DELAYED.
