Dear Representative Buchholdt:

The citizens of the Bristol Bay Borough have been trying to correct some of the inadequacies of their high school by passing bond issues for part of the proposed additions to the school. On March 13, 1979 a referendum in the amount of \$500,000 was passed by nearly a 2 to 1 margin.

The \$500,000 will go toward construction on a shop facility in which auto mechanics, welding and metal work can be added to our curriculum. However, an unhoued music program including vocal music (which now meets in the girls locker room when PE classes are not using the room) and band (which meets in our small cafeteria room around lunch schedules and with very poor acoustics) needs to have an acceptable place to meet, practice and perform.

Your committee is holding HB 129 which would provide funding to build the music facility and perhaps the third phase of the proposal which is a swimming pool.

It would certainly be beneficial to the students in the Bristol Bay Borough if you and your committee could release House Bill 129 granting funds to the Bristol Bay Borough for additional school facilities.
