10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The sum of \$9,704,650 ~~is~~ ^{9,004,650} appropriated from the general fund
 12 to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for school improve-
 13 ments in the following regional educational attendance areas in the amounts
 14 set out after each:

- 15 (1) Lake and Peninsula REAA -- \$3,769,750;
- 16 (2) Southwest Region REAA -- ~~2,875,000~~ ^{2,175,000} ~~-300,000~~
- 17 (3) Lower Kuskokwim REAA -- \$3,059,900.

18 * Sec. 2. The appropriation made by this Act is for capital projects and
 19 is subject to AS 37.25.020.

20 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
 21 070(c).

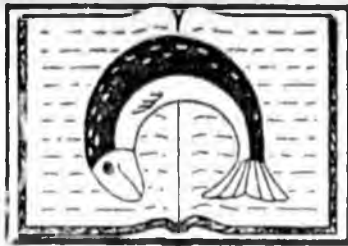
