6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to provision for adequate housing for

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.08.101 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (10) provide housing for rental to teachers, by leasing
11 existing housing from a local agency or individual, or by entering into
12 contractual arrangements with a local agency or individual to lease
13 housing which will be constructed by the local agency or individual for
14 that purpose.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 14.08.111 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

16 (9) provide prospective employees with information relating
17 to the availability and cost of housing in rural areas to which they
18 might be assigned, and, when possible, assist them in locating housing;
19 however, nothing in this paragraph requires a regional school board to
20 provide teacher housing, whether owned, leased, or rented or otherwise
21 provided by the regional educational attendance area, nor does it
22 require the board to engage in a subsidy program of any kind with
23 respect to teacher housing.

24 * Sec. 3. AS 14.14.090 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

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26 to the availability and cost of housing in rural areas to which they

3 * Sec. 4. AS 14.20.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (b) A certificate may not be revoked or suspended under (a)(3) or

6 certificate holder was based on the failure of the employing board to
7 comply with the provisions of AS 14.08.111(9) or AS 14.14.090(7).
