9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
11 the Alaska Native Child Welfare Task Force for the operations of the task
12 force during the period of its existence.

13 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the effective date of an Act estab-
14 lishing the Alaska Native Child Welfare Task Force.

The Department of Health and Social Services is in support of House Bill No. 385, making a special appropriation for the operation of the Alaska Native Child Welfare Task Force. The Indian Child Welfare Act imposes significant and far-reaching changes in operations for courts, attorneys, and agencies placing children in either foster care or adoption. A task force to study the various issues concerning child welfare services for Alaskan Natives would be very valuable in terms of future planning and policy development.
