RE: HCR 29

Following is a list of possible amendments to HCR 29 which you may wish to consider. These amendments are a product of considerations brought up in committee, and conversations with various Representative and Senators.

Page 2, line 7. Add "Alaska Association of Soil Conservation Sub-districts" (requested by Senator Gilman, Senate Resources)

This addition encourages involvement by and coordination with Soil Conservation Subdistrict representatives. These representatives are chosen by farmers from the agricultural regions in the State to take part in determining sound soil conservation practices and standards and to work with the Soil Conservation Association, U.S. Dept. of Agriculture.

Page 2, line 11-12. Change to read as follows: "the Alaska Agricultural Action Council to submit a report to the legislature. The report shall contain:"

Page 3, line 12. Add new section: "The first report shall be submitted to the legislature by the 45th day of the Second Session of the Twelfth Legislature. The second and final report shall be submitted by the 15th day of the First Session of the Thirteenth Legislature."

These changes would provide more time for completion of the ten (10) year plan and planning process. With time lag for funding availability considered this would increase total time for completion of plan from approximately eight (8) months to 1 1/2 years. Time available may actually be shorter than eight (8) months of 1 1/2 years if a portion of the plan is let to contract.

Page 2, line 17. Delete "annually".

Page 3, line 7. Change to read: "methods to ensure that in agricultural development other resources and resource uses be considered."

The following are proposed amendments to HB 535 relating to the Agricultural Action Council.

Page 1, line 15-16. Delete "the commissioner of transportation and public facilities, add "representative of the Governor's office".

Add new clause to include in membership of the council as non-voting advisory members, the commissioners of Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, and Department of Fish and Game.

Add new clause: "the House Speaker and Senate President shall each appoint member of the respective legislative body to serve as liason to the Council." Include with bill a letter of intent to clarify placement of Agricultural Action Council within Department of Commerce & Economic Development. (see attached.)

And so, the House adopted the FCC report, thus adopting: FCCS

The Chief Clerk was instructed to so notify the Senate.


