6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations to the Depart-  
7 ment of Fish and Game for bison management; and provid-  
8 ing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. The sum of \$25,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
11 the Department of Fish and Game to

12 (1) divert bison from farm crops in the Delta Junction area;  
13 (2) encourage bison migration to the Delta Junction Bison Range;  
14 and

15 (3) study fall bison migration patterns in order to develop  
16 methods of reducing bison damage to crops.

17 \* Sec. 2. The sum of \$250,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
18 the Department of Fish and Game to clear and plant soil on the Delta Junction  
19 Bison Range (AS 16.20.300) to provide alternate winter range and diversionary  
20 crops and forage for bison. The appropriation made by this section is  
21 contingent upon the signing of a cooperative bison management agreement  
22 between the Department of Fish and Game, the Alaska Agricultural Action  
23 Council (AS 44.33.450), and the United States Army commander at Fort Greely.

24 \* Sec. 3. The unexpended and unobligated portions of the appropriations  
25 made by this Act lapse into the general fund June 30, 1982.

26 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
27 070(c).




Re: Letter of intent - HB 83

Management for maximum sustained yield and productivity of the Bison Herd at Delta Junction shall be assured through complete evaluation of criteria including bull to cow ratios. The intention shall be to increase offspring and the annual harvestable surplus by hunters.

The base herd size shall be kept at its approximate current level of 250-450 animals, and not managed to increase beyond that maximum.

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
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
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
