9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. Article IX, sec. 8, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is  
11 amended to read:

12 SECTION 8. STATE DEBT. No state debt shall be contracted unless  
13 authorized by law for capital improvements or for housing assistance for  
14 residents of the state and ratified by a majority of the qualified  
15 voters of the State who vote on the question. The State may, as pro-  
16 vided by law and without ratification, contract debt for the purpose of  
17 repelling invasion, suppressing insurrection, defending the State in  
18 war, meeting natural disasters, or redeeming indebtedness outstanding  
19 at the time this constitution becomes effective.

20 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed  
21 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity  
22 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election  
23 laws of the state.
