5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to memorials to Alaskan veterans; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. MEMORIAL TO ALASKAN VETERANS. (a) A memorial to Alaskan
10 veterans shall be constructed by the Department of Transportation and Public
11 Facilities. The memorial shall be located in Denali State Park on a site
12 adjacent to the Parks Highway.

13 (b) The design of the memorial shall be chosen by a committee composed
14 *of one member of each of the Army, Air Force*
of the adjutant general of the state, two persons selected by the American
15 *Marines Navy Coast Guard*
Legion, and two persons selected by the Veterans of Foreign Wars. The
16 adjutant general shall be chairman of the committee.

17 (c) The memorial shall be maintained by the division of parks, Depart-
18 ment of Natural Resources.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 41.20.020 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:
20 (12) maintain memorials to Alaskan veterans located in state
21 parks.

22 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
23 070(c).
