Dear Mr. Tozer:

Enclosed is a resolution passed by the School Board on July 8, 1982, authorizing the reallocation of chapter 82-81 funds for the purchase of an existing building. The building to be purchased would be used for Correspondence Study, Special Education, Alternative High School, and District Central Offices.

The 1981 Legislature appropriated \$500,000 to be used for roof repairs at Delta Junction School. We are anticipating the roof repairs to cost approximately \$275,000. This would leave approximately \$225,000 remaining. We are presently in the final stages of this project. Because of this, our estimates are fairly accurate.

The 1980 Legislature appropriated \$200,000 for an administrative building in the Delta/Greely School District. Those funds were later reallocated by the Legislature to enable the District to award other projects that were being bid at the same time. Those projects were: a vocational education facility, library addition, and classrooms.

With the closing out of the above projects and the remaining funds from the Delta Junction Roof Project, we believe we could purchase an existing building. With the purchase of a building, I believe that we could save the District funds in the area of operations and maintenance of plant due to the fact that we are currently renting space at a cost of \$64,800 a year. We did bid an administrative building in the fall of 1980 using the \$200,000 appropriated. The low bid for 1,500 square feet of office space was \$351,000.

I formally request that the Department of Education assist the Delta/Greely School District with whatever action is necessary to allow the District to spend the remaining funds in chapter 82-81, roof repairs at

DELTA/GREELY SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS there is anticipated to be approximately \$225,000 remaining from Chapter 82-81; and

WHEREAS the Delta/Greely School District has a need for approximately 5,000 square feet of office space to house Correspondence Study, Special Education, Alternative High School, and the District's Central Offices; and

WHEREAS the District is presently renting space for Correspondence Study, Special Education, Alternative High School, and District Central Offices; and

WHEREAS the Delta/Greely School District is desirous of allocating the remaining funds in project 82-81, Delta Junction School Roof Repairs for the purchase of a building to be used to house Correspondence Study, Special Education, Alternative High School, and District Central Offices; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the funds remaining in Chapter 82-81 (Delta Junction School Roof Repairs) be reallocated for the purchase of an existing building to be used for Correspondence Study, Special Education, Alternative High School, and District Central Offices.
