11 providing for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 \* Section 1. The appropriations made by sec. 2 of this Act are for  
14 capital projects or are otherwise not one-year appropriations and do not  
15 lapse under AS 37.25.010.
