6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making a special appropriation to the Office  
7 of the Governor to fund the Task Force on Fire Pre-

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. The sum of \$20,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
12 to the Office of the Governor to fund the Task Force on Fire Prevention and  
13 Control.

14 \* Sec. 2. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the appropriation  
15 made by this Act lapses into the general fund 120 days after the effective  
16 date of this Act.

17 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the effective date of a version of  
18 "An Act providing for a task force on fire prevention and control; and  
19 providing for an effective date."

SUMMARY

HB 688 appropriates \$20,000 from the general fund to provide per diem and travel expenses to the Task Force on Fire Prevention and Control that is proposed in HB 687.

The unexpended or unobligated funds would lapse into the general fund at the end of 120 days.

HB 688 takes effect on the same date as its enabling legislation, HB 687.
