9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The sum of \$87,258 is appropriated from the general fund
11 to the Department of Health and Social Services for increased social
12 security costs for residential care facilities for children for the fiscal
13 year ending June 30, 1984. The appropriation shall be allocated as
