The reason for this resolution is to change the title of House Bill 399.

The Senate Transportation Committee heard HB 399 on May 17, 1984. At the time of the hearing the discussion centered around whether it was appropriate for the Legislature to mandate a the changing the name of a street in the municipality of Anchorage. All Committee members agreed that despite AS 19.10.085 which authorizes the Legislature to name all state maintained highways the Municipality of Anchorage should be the final authority on street names in the municipality. Under the original bill the municipality had no say over the name change. The Senate Transportation Committee has suggested a committee subsitute which will take affect only if the municipality of Anchorage passes a ordinance authorizing the name change. This action requires a title change. The original sponsor is in agreement with the title change.
