ADVISORY COMMISSION.

SPONSOR: FERGUSON

Creates the Capital Area Historic Properties Advisory Commission in the Office of the Governor to conduct research and make recommendations for preserving the historical integrity of the capitol and the governor's house in Juneau.

Is a 5-member commission. State historical architect serves ex officio. Other members are 1 Representative, 1 Senator, 2 Governor's appointments. Receive per diem and travel allowances.

Intent is to encourage "capital city spruce up".
