7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Sec. 37.15.720. STATE TOLL FACILITIES. The state is authorized
14 to acquire, construct, equip, and maintain toll bridges, tunnels,
15 highways, roads, crossings, and causeways found to be necessary by the
16 commissioner of transportation and public facilities.

17 * Sec. 3. AS 37.15.730 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 37.15.730. KNIK ARM CROSSING AND WHITTIER TOLL ROAD. (a)
19 Notwithstanding the provisions of AS 37.15.720 the first two state
20 toll facilities [FACILITY] to be financed under AS 37.15.610 - 37.15.-
21 760 are [IS] the Knik Arm Crossing and the Whittier Toll Road near
22 Anchorage if the following conditions are met:



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
