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EDUCATION COMMITTEE IN LEGISLATURE

WHEREAS, Alaska's commitment to education has made it available to all people;  
and

WHEREAS, the largest single element of the State Operating Budget is expended  
in support of education; and

WHEREAS, the state bureaucracy has a department of education unto itself; and

WHEREAS, the legislature currently addresses education issues in the Health,  
Education and Social Services (HESS) Committee; and

WHEREAS, the existing legislative HESS Committee must review many non-education  
concerns; and

WHEREAS, education in Alaska is too essential not to focus on it exclusively at  
the legislative committee level,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Association of Alaska School Boards endorses  
HCR 25 amending the Uniform Rules of the Alaska Legislature to create a separate  
education committee.
