7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
8 * Section 1. The Department of Fish and Game shall, during the next
9 three years, transplant to Zarembo Island or other appropriate locations in
10 Southeast Alaska, not fewer than 30 elk nor more than 150 elk. These elk
11 may not be taken from Afognak Island. The department shall utilize the
12 services of volunteers, organizations and groups to accomplish this
13 transplanting whenever possible.

ANALYSIS FOR HOUSE BILL 165

An Act relating to the transplanting of elk

Requires that the Department of Fish and Game transplant between 30 and 150 elk to Zarembo Island (near Wrangell) or to other appropriate places in Southeast. Elk may not be taken from Afognak Island which is near Kodiak.

The Department shall utilize the services of volunteers whenever possible.

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transplanting of elk."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. The Department of Fish and Game shall, over the next three
9 years, cooperate with and assist in the transplanting to Zarembo Island of
10 up to 50 but not less than 10 elk during the fiscal year ending June 30,
11 1986, up to 50 but not less than 10 elk during the fiscal year ending
12 June 30, 1987 and up to 50 but not less than 10 elk during the fiscal year
13 ending June 30, 1988. The department shall utilize the services of volun-
14 teers, organizations and groups to accomplish this transplanting whenever
15 possible. The department is authorized to enter into agreements with simi-
16 lar agencies in other states to facilitate this transplant.
