## ANALYSIS FOR SENATE BILL 167

An Act relating to dispensing opticians and optometrists

### Section 1

Would extend the life of the Board of Dispensing Opticians from June 30, 1985 to 1986.

### Section 2

Stipulates that the fees for examinations (tests) are raised from \$50 to \$175, initial licensing fee from \$50 to \$350 and renewal license (every 4 years) from \$200 to \$500. This section takes effect immediately.

### Section 3

States that the department shall raise fees in order to reflect actual costs to the department of the activity for which the fee is charged. However, the board must concur with the raising of these fees. This section does not take effect until 1986.

### Section 4

Currently an applicant must provide evidence of 15 hours of continuing competence in optical dispensing. This section raises that requirement to 30 hours.

### Section 5

Establishes a provision for the issuance of a temporary permit to operate as a dispensing optician.

### Section 6

Instructs the Governor to appoint a six-member working group to consider and make recommendations on the possible consolidation of the Board of Dispensing Opticians and Board of Optometric Examiners.

### Section 7

Repealer for section 6, July 1, 1986.

### Section 8

July 1, 1986 effective date for sections 3 and 7.

### Section 9

Immediate effective dates for sections 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6.
